Intro to Dance:

Ladies: Capezio’s Camisole leotard CC100C (child), CC100 (adult) in “Garnet”
Mirella’s wrap skirt S12 in “Garnet”

Capezios’ mesh tights with seams in “Classical Pink”: 9C (child), 9 (adult)

Men: White short sleeve T-shirt, black tights, black or tan dance belt, white ankle socks with white ballet slippers.

Ballet Foundations:

Ladies: same as above

Men: same as above

Intermediate Dance:

Ladies: same as above with the additions of the #9100 Flamenco skirt in Red and Black character shoes.

Men: same as above with the additions of a pair of Black dress pants with a Black belt, a White long sleeved shirt with a collar, and Black oxford dress shoes with a heel.

Corps Intensive:

Ladies: Capezio’s Camisole leotard CC100C (child), CC100 (adult) in “Garnet”
Mirella’s wrap skirt S12 in “Garnet”, pointe shoes

Black footless tights (If performing in the Modern piece)

Men: White short sleeve T-shirt, black tights, black or tan dance belt, white ankle socks with white ballet slippers. Black biker shorts

All levels will be asked to bring the same attire they wore for the “In-Studio” performance. If possible, additional costumes will be provided for you at no extra cost. Nude colored camisole to go underneath costumes

Pink ballet slippers, Pointe shoes for students dancing on pointe

Capezio’s Classical Pink mesh tights with seams

Character shoes for students in Flamenco

All Men:

Dance belt

One pair of Black ballet slippers

One pair of White ballet slippers

Flamenco class attire for men in Corps Intensive

White short sleeved T-shirt and Black footless tights for men in Intermediate Dance

Ms. Firicano collects students’ costume fees in January and purchases costumes from a costume warehouse for this performance. In addition, SBAZ and BAZ costumes may be used for those students in multiple pieces.
