For Contemporary/ Modern:

Students should wear:

- Comfortable pants that cover the knees (such as leggings, sweatpants, joggers, or capris) to allow for safe participation in floorwork. Pants should be form-fitting or lightly loose—not baggy, so instructors can clearly see body alignment and movement.
- Camisoles, tanks, t-shirts, or long sleeves that allow full range of motion.
- Shorts may be worn under pants, but no short shorts are allowed, and shorts alone are not appropriate for contemporary class.

The following are not permitted:

- Pants that drag on the floor or hang below the ankles.
- Midriffs/stomachs showing (students should be able to lift their arms without their shirt exposing their stomach).
- Cleavage, bras, or bralettes worn as tops.
- Extremely loose or oversized clothing that obscures the body (except in Hip Hop classes).
- Short shorts or shorts worn without pants in contemporary class.

Important: Students who are not dressed appropriately for class will be asked to observe and will not be permitted to participate that day.

Maintaining modesty in the classroom helps ensure physical and emotional safety between students and teachers, encourages a respectful studio culture, and promotes body positivity and focus among peers. By wearing clothing that supports both expression and comfort, dancers can move freely while honoring the shared values of our learning space.

Hip Hop: Students may wear comfortable, modest, and baggy
